



Ebola

Ebola virus disease (formerly known as Ebola haemorrhagic fever) is a severe, often fatal illness, with a death rate of up to 90% caused by Ebola virus, a member of the filovirus family. The Ebola virus was first identified in 1976 when 2 simultaneous outbreaks occurred, 1 in Yambuku, a village not far from the Ebola River in the Democratic Republic of Congo and the other in a remote area of Sudan. The origin of the virus is unknown, but current evidence suggests that fruit bats (Pteropodidae) may be a host.

In March 2014, a rapidly evolving outbreak of Ebola haemorrhagic fever started in Guinea. The outbreak subsequently spread to Liberia, Sierra Leone, Nigeria, Senegal, and Mali. --- 1 Aug 2014: WHO and the government of Sierra Leone, Guinea and Liberia launched a joint US\$ 100 million response plan. --- 8 Aug 2014: WHO declared the Ebola outbreak in West Africa a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC). --- 28 Aug 2014: WHO issued a "roadmap" to scale up the international response. --- 19 Sep 2014: UN Mission for Ebola Emergency Response (UNMEER) established. --- 17 Oct 2014: WHO declared Senegal free of Ebola virus transmission. --- 20 Oct 2014: WHO declared Nigeria free of Ebola virus transmission. --- 19 Jan 2015: WHO declared Mali free of Ebola virus transmission. --- 21 Jan 2015: Updated Overview of Needs and Requirements for Jan-Jun 2015 launched. --- 8 May 2015: WHO declared Liberia free of Ebola virus transmission. --- 31 Jul 2015: UNMEER closed and transitioned oversight of the UN system's Ebola emergency response to WHO as of 1 Aug. --- 7 Nov 2015: WHO declared Sierra Leone free of Ebola virus transmission. --- 29 Dec 2015: WHO declared the end of Ebola virus transmission in the Republic of Guinea. --- 14 Jan 2016: WHO declared the end of the most recent outbreak of Ebola virus disease in Liberia and said all known chains of transmission have been stopped in West Africa. --- 15 Jan 2016: A new case of Ebola has been confirmed in Sierra Leone. The country is still in a 90-day period of enhanced surveillance following the declaration on 7 November 2015 of the end of Ebola transmission in the country. --- 17 Mar 2016: WHO and the government of Sierra Leone marked the end of the recent flare-up of Ebola virus disease in the country. --- 18 Mar 2016: Guinean health officials in the region alerted WHO and partners on 16 March to 3 unexplained deaths in recent weeks in the village of Koropara and said other members of the same family are currently showing symptoms characteristic of Ebola. --- 29 Mar 2016: WHO said Ebola situation in West Africa no longer constitutes a Public Health Emergency of International Concern. --- 1 Jun 2016: WHO declares the end of Ebola virus transmission in the Republic of Guinea. --- 9 Jun 2016: WHO declares the end of the most recent Ebola virus disease outbreak in Liberia.
